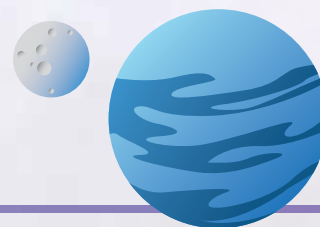
## THEME

## WHAT?

Two or three-dimensional, drawing, painting, sculpture, photography, or mixed media.

## WHAT SIZE?

From 8 x 10 inches up to 24 x 30 inches. Student collaborations of larger scale works need to be approved by Gallery Director, [neida@mauiarts.org](mailto:neida@mauiarts.org)

## HOW MANY?

The amount of artwork that teachers may submit is based on your school enrollment:

- 800 - 1000 students → up to 50 pieces total
- 300 - 800 students → up to 30 pieces total
- 100 - 300 students → up to 15 pieces total



- Craftsmanship is encouraged at all levels.
- Work that does not follow criteria will be disqualified.
- Work created in collaboration with adults will not be accepted.
- Individual works can be matted but framed work is not acceptable.
- Gallery staff will install all the submitted work.

## LABELS

On the back of each artwork include student name, school, grade level, and teacher name.
